BIG TALL PAUL settled in hand between horses, angled out five wide, split horses inside the three-sixteenths pole, finished with a surge and was up in the final strides. EL ALEMAN was unhurried into stride, angled in to save ground, closed the gap through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch, wore down the leader and edged clear inside the sixteenth pole, kept on well but was denied in the shadow of the wire. SPOON RIVER LEW set the pressured pace along the inside, weakened following a prolonged drive but had enough left to hold the show. B'WANAGOLDMINE settled saving ground, waited in traffic leaving the second turn, got through entering the stretch and was making up ground once clear. ANTRIM COUNTY was allowed to settle, ranged into contention between horses, angled out four wide and loomed a threat entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. CATCH TWENTY TWO made a mild rally circling six wide but failed to seriously threaten. BABY AFLEET pressed the pace three wide, was collared between horses, bumped with MALTESE DOG entering the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. BOYNAMEDTOMI failed to respond. MALTESE DOG settled along the inside, moved up swiftly through the second turn, shifted off of the rail inside the quarter pole, was forced out further when EL ALEMAN came out, bumped with BABY AFLEET near the three-sixteenths pole and came up empty thereafter. HARVEST DANCE was rank to place between horses, pulled to the lead between horses, disputed the pace for five furlongs and stopped.
