HARBORPLACE stalked the pace in hand, launched a bold bid three wide, took over and steadily drew clear. COUNT ON GOLD was allowed to settle off of the inside, swung five wide and finished willingly to earn the place. REBELS ROOST was unhurried into stride, settled saving ground, shifted out entering the stretch, split horses and was along for the show. FELA KUTI disputed the pace two wide, was unable to match strides with the winner leaving the second turn, then flattened between rivals in the final furlong and faded. GITTO vied for the lead along the inside to the stretch and tired. LAKE PLEASANT was hustled along four wide through the second turn and retreated. STEW BOY fought restraint and was rank into stride, settled at the tail of the field and was never a factor.
