Footnotes

REGALE, rated inside from early on, rallied between foes three wide at the quarter-pole, angled to the rail, gained command when roused, drew well clear and was gathered up very late. RUBIKISSES, outrun early, rallied from near the inside between foes and couldn't menace REGALE while best of the rest. EVIL EYE ALY raced forwardly near the inside throughout but was empty when the test came. SHOREWALK DRIVE, five or six wide throughout, lacked a late response. RUN WILLA RUN gained the lead early, moved near the inside, lost the advantage before going a half and gradually weakened. CLEVER MAID stalked the pace four wide into the final furlong and flattened out when the test came. FIRST LADY (ARG) broke slowly and awkwardly, then was outrun. A LITTLE GOLD pressed the pace from early on while three or four wide, gained the advantage on the turn but tired in the drive.
