BOLD STANDARD set the pressured pace off of the inside, kicked clear leaving the second turn and widened through the drive to score as the rider pleased. FOXTROT OSCAR contended between horses early, checked sharply leaving the first turn, settled into stride along the inside, angled out to make a late rally and was along for the place. EYES A THUNDER was caught in tight and steadied near the seven-eighths pole, moved up to a contending position three wide, flattened out entering the stretch but had enough left to hold the show. EXECUTIVE CHIEF stumbled at the start, rushed up along the inside, but faltered after six furlongs and faded. SHIP'S PIANO was allowed to settle, came four wide to make a belated gain but passed only the tiring ones. PRINCE DAVID was forwardly placed four wide, but drifted out leaving the second turn and faded. TARAGE saved ground to no avail. BIG BOLD PLACE was allowed to settle four wide and showed little in a dull effort. RAGPICKER'S SAINT was outrun.
