CHARM settled in behind rivals early, eased out four wide to rally approaching the stretch, then wore down TWO DOT SLEW under strong handling. TWO DOT SLEW pressed front-running ROSE FRANCES from early on, took over in the upper stretch, opened a clear advantage, then couldn't contain CHARM. DIXIE DELIGHT, outrun until the stretch, angled out for the drive and couldn't threaten the top two while improving position. PINK SLIP, outrun until the stretch while inside, moved out between foes for the drive and wasn't a threat while also improving position. ROSE FRANCES gained the lead inside early, made the pace until the stretch and tired. BIG M tracked the leaders four or five wide until the stretch and weakened. BABE TOO faded inside leaving the turn. ZIG'S QUIET LADY raced six wide throughout and failed to menace.
