Footnotes

BOURBON BAY stalked the pace along the inside, angled out leaving the turn to make his bid, opened clear entering the stretch and was fully extended to just last. DEVIL APPROVED IT was unhurried early, circled four wide and closed with a rush to just miss. COLE B attended the pace three wide, angled out four wide entering the stretch and was along in time to earn the show. DAYS ACTION angled in to save ground, advanced from between horses through the second turn, got through to continue the rally, but was caught in tight and clipped heels near the three-sixteenths pole and went evenly thereafter. REDEMPTION dueled for the lead along the inside, but weakened entering the stretch and gave way. FIRST ACTION HERO was hustled along in the second flight, came three wide to make a mild rally but failed to threaten. RESTLESS CITY dueled for the lead two wide for six furlongs and tired. SO VERY IRISH was allowed to settle into stride and failed to respond. AREYOUAPHI chased the pace three wide but came up empty leaving the second turn and dropped out. PITAYA was outrun.
