Footnotes

OUTTA TUNE stalked the pace two wide, wore down THE LAST WAVE after six furlongs, opened clear and increased his advantage under steady urging. THE LAST WAVE stumbled at the start, recovered quickly and opened clear to set the pace, was unable to match strides with the winner entering the stretch but finished fairly well to hold the place. GOLD BELLS SPIN contended along the inside, dropped off of the pace near the seven-sixteenths pole, got through and came again with a mild rally and was along for the show. MR. CHAMP was unhurried early, came four wide to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. EROBERER contended racing removed from the rail two wide, but drifted out further through the second turn and faded. STORMIN YANK settled saving ground, made a mild advance three wide through the second turn, but came up empty entering the stretch and retreated.
