Footnotes

PRIVATE GOLD, well placed from the outset while between foes five wide, continued from that position while advancing after front-running ECHEVERRIA, reached the front approaching the final furlong and was hard ridden the remainder. ECHEVERRIA drifted in bumping CAPTAIN AMOUR at the start, moved clear soon after, made the pace three wide, lost the edge to the winner at the furlong grounds and held on stubbornly the remainder as superior to the others. CAPTAIN AMOUR, bumped at the start, was outsprinted early, angled out for the drive, made a mild run to reach contention a furlong out and lacked a serious late bid. CHOCTAW CHARLIE settled early and wasn't a serious threat while improving position. HACKENDIFFY worked his way in six wide early, raced in contention into the lane and flattened out. K'S PATTON, never far back, moved in behind foes into the lane, continued inside and was empty the last eighth. CHICKEN SOUP KID drifted out at the start bumping LECTOR, raced forwardly inside into the lane and came up empty. BLACKJACK BOY failed to reach contention. PICK A WINNER MAX was outrun to the stretch and passed tired rivals. DANCINWITHTHUNDER was outrun. WILDCAT TRAITOR never was prominent. LECTOR, bumped at the break, forced the pace early while outside of ECHEVERRIA and tired on the turn.
