Footnotes

GRAND THEFT, never far back and five wide to the stretch, moved a bit wider and was under mild left-handed urging to edge clear late. GOLDEN VOICE gained a slight edge early while dueling three wide, battled forwardly into the final furlong and was not a match for the winner in the late going. NIP IT, within easy striking distance and in behind foes early, loomed a solid threat from between rivals four wide in the final furlong but couldn't muster the needed response. ALL FOR FASHION, outsprinted early and three or four wide, angled six wide for the drive and improved position. ARTEMUS RUNNER, never far back and inside, was steadied in tight quarters at the furlong grounds and was unable to recover. JUST GRIN'N dueled for the lead outside of GOLDEN VOICE into the final furlong and weakened. CHARMED BEHAVIOUR, four or five wide, offered no rally.
