WHITEWOOD INDIAN settled in hand five wide, closed the gap through the second turn, forged command with a furlong to run, brushed with ALEXANDER THEGREAT in the drive and gamely edged clear. ALEXANDER THEGREAT stalked the pace off of the inside, bid between horses, gained a narrow lead leaving the second turn, dug in to meet the challenge of WHITEWOOD INDIAN, brushed with that one in the drive and grudgingly gave in. SHOOTDEWORX was away a step slow, was unhurried into stride, moved up five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. SILVER WINGS tracked the pace four wide, but weakened between horses entering the stretch and faded. KUMACANDU settled between horses, steadied near the five-sixteenths pole, angled out and finished with a belated gain. LION'S DUB was close up between horses for five furlongs and tired. SORGHO saved ground to little avail. COWCUTTA opened clear to set the pace, was collared on the second turn and gave way readily once headed. PROSPECT ROAD broke slowly and was outrun.
