CAPTAINOF THE NILE settled in hand, split horses leaving the turn, loomed large entering the stretch, poked his head in front with a furlong to run and edged clear. RUNKLE sped clear to set the pace, increased the advantage on the turn, continued on well but was unable to resist the winner. ROCKIN DONOVAN contended four wide, was carried out on the turn, but kept on and was making up ground. DEMANDER was unhurried into stride, came four wide, split horses and improved position. TIZ A STAR was bumped hard at the start, was unhurried into stride, angled out entering the stretch and finished with a belated gain. TRIBUNUS contended off of the inside, moved up between horses to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. CLEVER FOX was jostled between horses at the start and passed only the tiring ones. BIRD TAP broke slow and was never a factor. BAD BOB was close up along the inside to the stretch and dropped out. BULLMANIA broke outwardly, bumped CLEVER FOX at the start, rushed up between horses, was carried out on the turn and stopped before going a half. WINNING DIAMOND chased four wide, drifted out through the turn and retreated.
