### Footnotes

MARKET MOVER, rated in behind leaders early while between foes, moved out four or five wide to rally nearing the stretch and outgamed FARGO the last eighth. FARGO went up to vie for the lead early while outside MARTE, lost the lead to that one leaving the backstretch, dug in to gain about even terms leaving the eighth pole but couldn't handle MARKET MOVER. MARTE, close up inside from the start, gained the lead after five furlongs, held on well into the final furlong and weakened. BALLISTIC, reserved in behind the leaders until nearing the stretch, came out five wide for the drive but failed to respond. INTERPOL bobbled soon after the start, followed the leaders four or five wide and couldn't threaten. SONAR SYSTEMS forced the pace three abreast to the far turn and tired.
