BRILLIANT ASSET settled inside early, was shuffled back nearing the stretch, rallied between foes, came out six wide and was fully extended to be along in time. KNUCKLEHEAD, bumped at the start and racing inside throughout, rallied from the rail, reached the front in very deep stretch but was outfinished. MARKADA contested the pace inside RACING RUBY early, eased outside that one four wide on the backstretch, took over and opened a clear advantage, then wasn't quite good enough. SPANISH LASS tracked the pace from early on while four or five wide, raced within easy striking distance but was empty the last eighth. JEANIE SUE, unhurried early while racing in behind rivals, angled out for the drive but lacked a serious response. ANGIE'S CAT leaned in at the start bumping KNUCKLEHEAD, was unhurried, moved out four wide on the backstretch and failed to menace. RACING RUBY gained a slim lead early, moved inside, drew clear, made the pace until the stretch and faltered in the drive. RE LYD tired on the far turn.
