TREATY OF KADESH broke slow, tucked in to save ground, took closer order after a half, waited in traffic near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out and split horses leaving the second turn, and steadily drew away once clear. COMMADORE KATE settled in hand, moved with the winner on the backstretch, drew even with five-sixteenths to run, kept on well but was no match for the winner. WITTY AND WISE made a middle move four wide, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive and settled for the show. KAZ U CAN set the pressured pace along the inside, but came up empty leaving the second turn and retreated. BOM BABY failed to respond. LUZ DEL NORTE vied for the lead three wide for five furlongs and stopped.
