### Footnotes

TRUE PARADISE was close up between horses, altered out to the four path on the turn, forged command entering the stretch and held stubbornly. GEOTHERMAL was forwardly placed between horses, was bumped and steadied near the seven-sixteenths, tucked in on the turn, angled out entering the stretch, finished willingly but was unable to reach the winner. CIRCUS CLOWN stumbled at the start, rushed up four wide, contested the issue to the final furlong and gave way. FRANKIE AND JOE opened clear, drifted out a bit entering the turn, was headed before going a half and gave way readily. TOBIAS broke slow and passed only the tiring ones. ROMAN RAIDER contended between horses, steadied near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty thereafter. ELUSIVE ENERGY showed little. The jockey of GEOTHERMAL lodged an objection against the winner for alleged interference entering the turn, but following a Stewards review there was no change to the order of finish.
