NICKLAUS WAY reserved three wide, moved up near the rail after five furlongs, worked his way through traffic approaching the stretch, angled out for a clear path in upper stretch, moved back in, challenged with a furlong to go and drew clear late. UNLATCH fractious in the gate, hesitated at the start, was outrun for a half, made a bold four wide move on the second turn, challenged entering the stretch, drifted in with a furlong to go when challenging then held on to be second best. MYKINDAGOLD closest to the pace off the inside, gained a short lead on the second turn, battled into the final furlong and tired. GOVERNMENT ROAD within striking distance, raced off the rail on the second turn, clipped heels just past the quarter mile marker then tired. LUMBERJACK within reach along the inside, stayed on to the stretch and tired. BETTERLOOKOUT sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace inside and tired in the stretch. ARCH OF TITUS was outrun. ZARKING sluggish at the start, quickly gained a forward position, held on well for six furlongs and faded.
