REFLECTION BAY, rated inside early, moved out four wide to take over nearing the end of the backstretch, remained well off the inside the remainder and was under intermittent urging to hold sway. BE A LEGEND, unhurried for a half, made a bold run five wide nearing the stretch, loomed through the drive but wasn't good enough. ORNATE, well placed always, dropped inside the leaders when straightened for the drive but lacked a final response. JOVE'S AUBEE, outrun for a half, reached contention nearing the stretch while five or six wide and lacked a late bid. LADY WOODWIN, outrun until nearing the stretch, came out seven wide for the drive but failed to gain in the final furlong. DENZIL'SFIRSTBABY, five or six wide throughout, flattened out when the test came. MILAN'S MELODY failed to seriously menace. GRECIAN ROSE was done early. FANCY CHANCE tired upon going a half. PRINCESS IVORINA gained the lead early, showed the way for nearly a half and gave way. SHAM'S EXCEL GAL was outrun.
