Footnotes

SUDDENLY GONE stalked the leaders from early on while four wide, took over leaving the furlong grounds, drifted in slightly approaching the wire and was kept to her task. THUNDER SANDS vied for the lead outside of OVERDRAWN early, gained the edge in the upper stretch, weakened and was checked nearing the wire when the winner leaned in. MISSY STAR followed the leaders in a striking position five wide throughout and was empty the last eighth. WISHING SANDS swung out five wide for the drive and lacked a closing bid. OVERDRAWN drifted out at the start while gaining the lead, held a slight edge while dueling with THUNDER SANDS into the stretch and tired. UNBELIEVABLE RUN ducked out at the start jolting BIG HEART, was never close and drifted out on the turn. BIG HEART, slammed at the start and checked, was outrun. RED STORM BOOTS was finished after three-eighths. A foul claim by the rider of THUNDER SANDS against the winner for alleged interference approaching the wire was disallowed.
