Footnotes

CABERNEIGH, never far back and four or five wide, continued five wide into the stretch, reached the front approaching the final furlong and was ridden hard the remainder. HORSE DOCTOR, six wide from the first turn on, continued off the inside, moved menacingly into the final furlong but wasn't good enough. GRAND MOUNTAIN stalked the pace four or five wide, was inside the leaders for the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. PRINCE HOPE, unhurried for six furlongs, moved three wide into the stretch and managed a mild gain. BUNKER moved to the front three wide, managed a slight edge to the stretch and weakened. NORTH OF TOWN, outrun to the lane, was eight wide in the drive and couldn't make a serious impact. DIAMONDS IN DIXIE failed to menace. TOVAH forced the pace outside of BUNKER four wide, raced up close for six furlongs and weakened. CELTIC CHIEF, well placed three or four wide, was finished leaving the second turn. PULPIT'S JET tired leaving the backstretch.
