**Footnotes**

LEISURE, never far back while following the dueling leaders four wide, continued four wide into the stretch and closed determinedly under urging to be along in time. DAYLATEDOLLARSHORT, forwardly placed inside from the outset, gained the advantage in the upper stretch, briefly was clear, then couldn't contain the winner's surge. SOUNDS OF SILENCE broke slowly, moved near the inside, continued inside into the lane, worked her way out eight wide in the final furlong and finished well. CRAZY THING gained a slight lead while battling three abreast, held on well into the upper stretch and weakened. GOLDEN DAWN, up close five wide, weakened leaving the turn. STRIKES A CHORD, between foes four or five wide, raced in a striking position but failed to fire. HERONTHEHEARTLAND was outrun to the stretch and improved position while never a threat. NATURAL TENDANCY attended the pace between foes to the lane and gradually weakened. FEVERED PITCH never reached contention. FANTASTIC DANCER was outrun. MONT STELLA, bumped and forced out at the start, drifted out on the turn and never seriously menaced. SMILE TRAIN stumbled at the start, swerved out on MONT STELLA, raced six or seven wide and tired nearing the lane.
