CASH PRINCESS swerved out at the start bumping FEARLESS RISKTAKER, was never far back while following the leaders from the outside, rallied four wide into the stretch, gained command, then was kept to her task to hold MISS LUCY safe. The latter, steadied between foes in tight quarters at the seven-sixteenths pole, angled out five wide to rally, closed well but wasn't good enough. COLONIA'S TRUTH, outrun to the stretch, found her best stride late. LADY MONARCH improved position while not a threat. SIMPS went up early to force the pace from the outside, battled on about even terms into the upper stretch and weakened. FEARLESS RISKTAKER, bumped at the start, gained the lead and maneuvered inside, made the pace to the stretch and tired. MINORE AFFAIR raced forwardly between foes to the stretch and gave way. DINKY ANNIE saved ground but tired. PRINCESS OLIVIA was outrun. This race was hand timed. The electronic timer malfunctioned.
