Footnotes

RED RAYMOND, never far back and three or four wide, was alertly angled to the rail leaving the quarter-mile ground, then was under solid urging to edge clear late. CATCOMINATCHA, rated in behind the dueling leaders early, eased out between foes to advance four or five wide into the stretch, loomed menacingly on even terms leaving the eighth pole but wasn't good enough. DEPUTY G bobbled slightly in his second or third stride, moved up soon after three wide to gain a slim lead, battled inside of FINAL COPY, shook him off entering the stretch but faltered in the late going. RAYWICK, outrun for a half, made a mild bid five or six wide into the upper stretch but couldn't muster a late response. FINAL COPY broke in front, vied for the lead outside of DEPUTY G until nearing the final quarter and weakened. MIKO raced three or four wide and was finished upon going a half.
