INSANE WAIN vied for the lead three wide and drew clear under steady urging. COPEINWITHTHETIGER alternated for the lead along the inside and held on for the place. SPEEDING TRAIN reserved early, commenced his rally near the rail with three furlongs to go, angled out for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. MAD AFTERSHOCK forced the pace between rivals and tired. N EIGHTEEN reserved early, raced four wide into the turn and could not menace. GOLDEN RON outrun early, was no factor. ARTEMUS JOY five wide into the turn when well back, never reached contention. SPICEY WORLD behind the leaders off the rail, faded. MR. CASUAL prominent inside, stopped.
