THERES ALWAYS HOPE opened clear to dictate terms and remained unchallenged. REQUITAL was forwardly placed four wide, failed to menace the winner but kept on well to prove second best. DAKOTA DIM was allowed to settle, circled five wide and was just up to earn the show. LE BEE was caught in tight near the seven-sixteenths pole, was rank to place to the turn, wheeled out five wide and made a mild bid entering the stretch but came up empty in the drive. HONEY C contended toward the inside through the turn and weakened. MAIA'S STAR was close up between horses to the stretch and tired. JOHN D'S VALENTINE was allowed to settle, was caught in tight early and showed little thereafter. CASSIES HOPE showed little.
