Footnotes

ANNIE'S APPLE settled early, rallied four wide entering the stretch and, concluding a stiff drive, wore down MARSHEW. The latter sprinted clear, made the balance of the pace and failed to last. COVER YOUR EARS saved ground, rallied from between horses entering the stretch but failed to offer a late response. CRIMSON ROAD, outrun to the stretch, circled horses seven wide, reached contention in the upper stretch but failed to sustain the needed momentum. CRAFTIMAE was used up early as was UNIQUE EXEMPLAR when forcing the early pace.
