Footnotes

ALWAYS SURE settled inside early, saved ground while working her way forward on the second turn, angled out to go after front-running CAT CITY, caught that one at the sixteenth pole and edged clear under pressure. CAT CITY, never far back, moved three wide to take over in the upper stretch, drew clear but couldn't handle the winner late. LETEM TALK, outrun for a half, moved between foes five wide nearing the stretch, loomed prominently but could gain only slightly at the end. VAPORIFIC, well placed inside to the stretch, came up empty when the test came. GUSHER dueled for the lead inside of MICHELLEMYBELLE, gained a narrow advantage, held on well for six furlongs and tired. NORTHERN CHARMER followed the leader four or five wide and tired. STONE ALLEY was squeezed back in tight quarters at the start and wasn't a factor. MICHELLEMYBELLE stopped after dueling for the lead the opening half through rapid fractions.
