IFFY gained a clear lead early, was headed briefly on the turn from the outside by GORGEOUS LAKE, recaptured the advantage and drew off under strong handling. SAVANNAH HANNA, never far back, made a solid bid five wide nearing the stretch, loomed prominently but couldn't threaten the winner late while fully extended. GORGEOUS LAKE went up early to press the winner four wide, put her head in front briefly just prior to going a half, then was empty when straightened for the drive. SEE THE STARS, in contention throughout, was empty when the test came. KNUCKLEHEAD settled near the inside early, made a mild run to reach contention in the upper stretch and failed to continue. OH MY LOVE failed to menace. TALLY SLEW broke in a tangle, rushed up five wide and tired upon going a half. A RARE BRUNSWICK tired inside early.
