HOLD THE SALT pressed the pace off the rail, gained a short lead with a half mile to go after his rider lost his whip, repulsed a bid by GEORGE RAY leaving the second turn and drew off while doing his best. GUN SALUTE four wide early when reserved, angled to the outside for the drive and rallied belatedly for the place. CHESTERMITE within striking distance off the rail, dropped back before a half, angled out for the drive but could not threaten with a late bid. WATCHINGIRLSGOBY close up along the inside, moved off the rail late on the second turn and tired. GEORGE RAY forwardly placed three wide, moved in a bit and made a run at the winner late on the second turn but tired in the drive. TIMBUCTO vied for the lead along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired.
