BEARLY SMILING gained the lead at the start, went along under careful handling through rapid fractions, shook off SERIOUS TROUBLE in the upper stretch and was under urging to hold MORNING SPLENDOR safe. The latter, outsprinted early, rallied five wide entering the stretch, loomed prominently outside the winner but wasn't good enough. SERIOUS TROUBLE went up to vie for the lead outside the winner early and weakened in the drive. LESLIE'S LADY saved ground, attempted to angle out at the sixteenth pole, couldn't when lacking room and came up empty. SKY MINISTER raced within easy striking distance but failed to rally. MARVELLOUS SILVER improved position while not a threat. STINT failed to menace. TAMARINE was outrun. MS. NOLIN swerved out badly at the start, was checked and never close.
