Footnotes

LITTLE REALFIRE, never far back, moved four wide on the second turn, took over leaving the eighth pole, then withstood CIMPLY SAVIO under steady urging. CIMPLY SAVIO, unhurried early and saving ground, elected to advance between horses into the upper stretch, loomed solidly inside the winner through deep stretch and wasn't good enough. FOREVER SONIC, outrun until the stretch, swung out eight wide for the drive and offered a minor gain. FRANCIS NOLEN broke awkwardly and was steadied, recovered to race forwardly, moved up to vie for the lead nearing the end of the backstretch, gained a slim advantage, held on well into the final furlong and weakened. CRUISE ACROSS gained a slight edge inside early, dueled for the lead until the stretch and tired. SWEET LAUR failed to menace. LT. DOLLY moved up early to duel for the lead outside of CRUISE ALONG, held on well for a half and weakened thereafter.
