AMUSINGLY, outsprinted early, settled in behind horses, came out six wide for the drive and prevailed under hand urging. FLAMING DIXIE broke in the air, quickly recovered to gain a position near the inside between foes, loomed boldly between foes four wide in the drive and wasn't good enough in a game effort. RARE GLITTER gained a slight edge inside early, dueled with MIGHTY PATRIOT into the final furlong and grudgingly weakened. DANDY ROSE tracked the leaders four or five wide into the final furlong and lacked a final a response. YUKI NO PRINCESS, within striking distance along the inside throughout, lacked a late response. PARISIAN DEPUTY, outrun from early on, came out eight wide for the drive and couldn't produce a late response. MIGHTY PATRIOT dueled for the lead outside of RARE GLITTER into the final furlong and weakened.
