LOOKN MIGHTY FAST rushed up from between horses to vie for the lead, battled through a long drive and gamely kicked clear in the final sixteenth. GOLDEN COUNTRY settled saving ground, shifted out in the upper stretch, finished willingly and was making up ground. INDIAN SILVER stalked the pace, bid three wide entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. HARLAN STREET was allowed to settle into stride, came four wide to make a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. PILLAR OF SALT lunged at the start to get away behind his field, made a mild rally from between horses but was never a factor. ART AND SOUL was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside, but faltered from between horses leaving the turn and dropped out. RAGPICKER'S SAINT was overmatched and always outrun.
