Footnotes

CHAMPALI gained a slim lead early, moved near the inside, dueled with FOTOCAT, shook off that one, drew clear into the lane, then was ridden hard to hold sway. CHEROKEE PRINCE, within striking distance while in behind horses to the stretch, swung out five or six wide for the drive and was going well at the end. BRICK'S drifted in at the start bumping SNOW BLASTER, was well placed, raced between foes four wide and lacked a final response. ELUSIVE MAGIC, within easy striking distance while in behind rivals, angled out for the drive and failed to offer a late account. MACON'S BLUFF ducked out at the start bumping TRIPLE AUGHT, followed the leaders five wide into the stretch and came up empty. MADE FOR TAYLOR, bumped at the start, was checked when squeezed back in tight quarters, was outrun to the lane, then offered a minor gain from between foes. TRIPLE AUGHT, bumped at the start and forced out, wasn't a factor. FOTOCAT went up early to battle for the lead outside the winner, challenge earnestly concluding the turn but weakened in the drive. SUPREMETTA broke slow and was outrun. SNOW BLASTER came over on MADE FOR TAYLOR at the start and faded nearing the stretch. SAND TRAPPER was outrun.
