**Footnotes**

MT. BONSI gained a narrow advantage early while near the inside, dueled with TAXIBLE, shook off that one at the far turn, was engaged nearing the stretch from the rail by MOSTBEAUTIFULSOUND and outside by JOVE'S AUBEE, edged clear and prevailed under hand urging. JOVE'S AUBEE, never far back while tracking the winner four wide, challenged earnestly nearing the final quarter but couldn't match strides in the drive as second best. SUN AT MIDSUMMER, outrun to the far turn, made a run five wide into the stretch, reached contention but could gain only slightly in the late stages. MOSTBEAUTIFULSOUND, squeezed back and checked in tight quarters soon after the start, moved to the rail, made a bold run nearing the final quarter but failed to continue when straightened for the drive. EMISARIA (IRE) tired after five furlongs. TAXIBLE pressed the winner to the far turn and tired. LILY RED HONEY gave way early.
