GAUCHO GIRL sprinted clear near the inside early, made the balance of the pace and was kept to her task in the drive. PAPA SIDS GIRL, well placed inside to the stretch, eased out three or four wide for the drive and was clearly second best. CAT IN THE TREE, outrun four wide to the lane, came out six wide for the drive, reached contention but lacked a final account. CHAFFED LIPS, outsprinted early and inside to the lane, eased out three wide for the drive but lacked a serious late bid. THATKRAZYKAT, within striking distance into the upper stretch while four or five wide, came up empty. SHEZYOU BREWING chased the winner four wide to the stretch and tired. O'LEE'S STORY raced five wide and tired.
