CITIZEN JOHN stalked the leaders four wide, took over when straightened into the stretch, then was under mild urging. SUPERSECRETDEVICE, within easy striking distance, made a solid bid four or five wide into the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. CORNWHISKEY, outrun to the lane, made a bold run five wide into the final furlong, angled inside the leaders late and was going well. QUATRE V., never far back, moved menacingly into the upper stretch but flattened out late. WHAT A PLACE, outrun to the lane, managed a minor gain. BOOKER forced the pace early, gained the advantage before going a half, held on well to the stretch and faltered. ELEANOR'S GROOM never was prominent. ALABAMA VOW attended the pace for a half and tired. DANGEROUS DUDE tired approaching the stretch.
