WAKES WEEK stalked the pace in hand, moved up four wide to engage the leaders midway through the second turn, forged command entering the stretch and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. CITIZEN JOHN set the pressured pace along the inside, battled gamely through a prolonged drive but wasn't quite good enough. ROMAN SUR prompted the pace two wide, weakened between horses in the drive but stayed on to hold the show. MR. REALISTIC settled saving ground, finished with a mild gain but failed to threaten. JAYBIRD'S MIRACLE failed to respond. GREAT RISK was outrun.
