**Footnotes**

KEY TO POWER outrun along the inside, moved between rivals after six furlongs, angled back to the rail in upper stretch, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and edged clear. SOUND EFFECT within striking distance near the rail, moved out three wide on the second turn when advancing between rivals, came a bit wider for the drive but lodged only a mild bid for the place. DREAM MAN reserved off the rail, steadied in traffic while four wide midway through the second turn, rallied between horses into the stretch and finished gamely. TILDEN LANE awkward at the start, quickly gained a forward position, challenged before a half, battled to the final furlong and weakened. BRAVEMAN close up from the start, made a run at the leaders from the three path on the second turn but tired in the drive. CALLINGAHARDTEN within striking distance, raced four wide on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and tired. FRISCO EXSECTIVE alternated for the lead inside, came off the rail on the second turn, steadied when in tight near the quarter mile marker and faded. DUKE OF DEL REY vied for the lead from the start, saved ground on the second turn and gave way in the stretch.
