ROYAL BEAN settled inside, rallied from the rail, took over, then drew well clear under hand urging. MARCHELLA ducked in at the start on SURELY JANE, was never far back, moved inside leaving the backstretch, eased out late but couldn't menace the winner while fully extended. DOMESTIC ARTS gained the lead at the start, held a slight edge three wide early, was between foes for most of the final six furlongs and weakened in the drive. MOODY WOMAN settled inside early, moved four wide leaving the second turn, angled six wide at the eighth pole but failed to respond late. OUI MARIE failed to rally in an even effort. EYEFUL stalked the pace four or five wide into the stretch and flattened out. SURELY JANE, bumped at the start and forced in, wasn't a factor. WILLS EASY contested the pace four wide and tired upon going a half.
