Footnotes

VALIDATOR, in hand early, moved inside on the backstretch, edged up behind foes on the far turn, split rivals entering the upper stretch and drove clear. EL CHILE DOG, reserved early and angled inside, was outrun for six furlongs, circled foes nine or 10 wide into the lane and was going well at the end. MURCH, unhurried early, made a menacing move five wide into the stretch, gained even terms for the lead but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. APOGEE DANCER gained the lead early, was clear on the first turn, lost the edge on the backstretch, fell back on the far turn, then improved position at the end while not a threat. DES ARTISTES, never far back and near the inside between foes,, remained a factor into the final furlong and failed to fire. ELECTRIC CHANT, bumped at the start by ATLANTIC IDOL and carried out on the first turn, continued to drift entering the backstretch while racing greenly, was straightened, went up to force the pace on the far turn, reached the front but weakened the last eighth. LAWYER RON gained a forward position between horses early, raced up close four wide into the final furlong and flattened out. TEMPLAR'S CUP never menaced. BECK AND CALL tired on the far turn. ATLANTIC IDOL came out at the start bumping ELECTRIC CHANT, drifted out carrying that one out on the first turn, moved to the front on the backstretch three or four wide, held on well for six furlongs and gave way.
