### Footnotes

HERSILIA was unhurried off of the inside, wheeled out seven wide leaving the turn, finished with a rush and wore down the leader in the final yards. ANGEL OF MUSIC set the pressured pace along the inside, edged clear entering the stretch, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. DOWOOOPER settled saving ground, shifted out leaving the turn, split horses and was making up ground. EMBELLISHED GOLD attended the pace along the inside, waited in traffic leaving the turn, got through but lacked the needed late response. THE MIMOSA LADY was allowed to settle, circled six wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. AUTUMN EYES chased three wide to the stretch but came up empty between horses. ITS TRUE TYPE passed only the tiring ones. SINGLEBLING was through early. BUFFALO RIVER GAL pressed the pace three wide through the turn and stopped.
