FAST DELIVERY, never far back, moved six wide when advancing towards the stretch, took over when straightened for the drive, then was hard ridden to hold BET THE FARMA safe. The latter, well placed four or five wide from early on, loomed prominently inside the winner for the final furlong and wasn't good enough. COLOR ME CHROME, never far back and saving ground for nearly six furlongs, swung out seven wide for the drive and closed well. MY SWEET CAROLINE went up early to vie for the lead outside of WINGS OVER TEXAS, took a narrow advantage, made the pace until the stretch and weakened. DRIVE THRU BLUES, outrun until the stretch, passed only tired ones. HERE'S KITTY stalked the pace four wide until the stretch and flattened out. WINGS OVER TEXAS dueled for the lead to the far turn, gave way and was distanced.
