BRILLIANT ASSET gained the lead near the inside early, controlled the pace three wide and was kept to his task in the late going to widen a bit. TEJANO'S ECHO, seven wide early, edged in five wide on the turn, made a run outside the winner into the stretch but couldn't match strides in the drive as second best. SURE SPECIAL raced forwardly between foes four wide to the stretch and was empty when the test came. SASSY SIX, five or six wide on the backstretch, was outrun to the stretch and offered a mild gain. SHAGSVILLE settled three or four wide, offered a mild bid into the upper stretch while five wide and failed to continue. GATOR MAID stalked the pace four or five in a striking position for nearly six furlongs and tired. RED BRICK AVENUE tired leaving the backstretch. KAT CAN DANCE chased the winner for nearly a half while four wide and tired.
