CURSESANDBLESSINGS outrun for a half, advanced five wide into the stretch and closed well to be up in time. TACTICAL SOLUTION reserved, moved up three wide late on the second turn, gained a short lead in deep stretch but was outfinished. DON'T JUDGE ME unhurried early, advanced four wide into the stretch, challenged inside the final furlong and held on gamely. ROBIN'SONAROLL behind the leaders, moved up three wide after a half, challenged on the second turn, took over for the drive but faltered late. ADDISON N CLARK closest to the pace, challenged from the rail on the second turn, battled into deep stretch and weakened. NAFASS lacked a bid inside. DIAMONDS ARE IN sprinted clear, set a quick pace and tired in the final quarter.
