Footnotes

DON'T SHOOT tracked the pace off of the inside, launched his bid three deep, and was fully extended to wear down the determined SHARKIOWA in the final yards. The latter opened clear to dictate terms, dug in gamely to meet the bid of DON'T SHOOT but wasn't quite good enough. FAITHOPE settled along the inside, angled to the outside entering the turn, circled five wide and was along for the show. EXTREME WARRIOR broke a step slow, advanced between horses, came four wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. STIG'S DEPUTY chased the pace three wide, came four wide into the stretch, but weakened between horses and faded. CHIS MAGIC was forwardly placed three wide through the turn and tired. JUMP 'IEN trailed.
