Footnotes

ALJANEL tracked the pace along the inside, shifted out to make her bid, wore down ABELIA inside the furlong marker and held sway under steady urging. ABELIA settled in hand, advanced between horses through the turn, angled out and came four wide, finished well and was gaining with every stride. SMART REASON opened clear to set the pace, dug in to meet the challenge of ALJANEL, but weakened slightly and grudgingly gave way. FLEETING FROLIC was allowed to settle, got through to make a late rally and improved position. SNEAK AROUND contended between horses, came three wide but weakened in the drive and faded. RUN DORIS ONE was allowed to settle, angled in and got through to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. INDIAN NATIVE passed only the tiring ones. ASIAN PROVERB chased the pace four wide, but drifted out leaving the turn and retreated. MADDY MY GIRL was hustled along five wide, but came up empty before going a half and dropped out. DALLAS SUNSET broke slow and was never a factor. MAMBO CHACHACHA was outrun.
