Footnotes

ON MY WAY settled under a snug hold, tucked in on the second turn, weaved her way through horses and into contention, split horses and angled out entering the stretch, and quickly kicked clear. LADY LARKSPUR contested the pace along the inside, kept on well through a prolonged drive but was no match for the winner late. ROCK HARD BABY settled between horses near the tail of the field, worked her way forward through the second turn, came four wide to make her bid but lacked the needed late response. DITCH THE ACT settled in hand along the inside, moved up to make a mild bid with a quarter to run but failed to sustain the drive. KAZOOM was unhurried into stride, circled five wide and finished with a belated gain. CLARA'S GROVE passed only the tiring ones. BIT OF HEAVEN vied for the lead three wide, but came up empty leaving the second turn and dropped out. ALLEVIATE was rank to place, pulled to contention four wide, but stopped before going six furlongs.
