Footnotes

BRAND NEW DREAM, outrun for a half, rallied steadily five wide on the stretch turn, took over when straightened for the drive and drove clear late under strong handling. WHATHEMATTERBOOBOO, never far back, raced in behind the leaders until nearing the final quarter, swung out six wide for the drive and was second best. CIELO ROSE gained the lead at the start, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and weakened. SHESAGAMER, outrun until the stretch, improved position while not a threat. COURAGEOUS FIGHTER stalked the pace from early on, gained near even terms for the lead nearing the final quarter but flattened out in the drive. FAIRY DUST pressed the pace from the beginning, put a head in front just before going six furlongs but weakened in the drive. MORISOT, within striking distance, angled out to commence a run four or five wide nearing the stretch, then broke down and fell at the three-sixteenths pole.
