Footnotes

THUNDER SANDS moved up soon after the start to press front-running ATONE while four wide, headed that one a furlong out and was hard ridden the remainder. ATONE gained the lead early, edged inside, made the pace until the final furlong, lost the edge to the winner and held on stubbornly the remainder. MISSY STAR, within striking distance while near the inside into the stretch, angled five wide in the final sixteenth and offered a mild gain. BLUE'S RIVER GAL, outrun until the stretch, offered a slight gain while not a threat. CELESTIAL SEA, outsprinted into the stretch, came out eight or nine wide for the drive and couldn't menace while improving position. DIZ L FITER raced forwardly near the inside into the upper stretch and flattened out. ROENA, well placed for three furlongs while between foes, weakened thereafter. BLACK TIE COUNTESS was outrun. CAMETOPLAY tracked the leaders five wide until the stretch and tired. TOOT'S CLASSIC was outrun.
