Footnotes

NATIVE FEVER, reserved near the inside between foes early, advanced four wide when rallying on the far turn, took over about the sixteenth pole and drove clear. AFFORDABILITY tracked the pace under light rating four or five wide, gained the advantage just before entering the far turn, held on well into the final furlong and couldn't handle NATIVE FEVER while fully extended to save the place. CARLISLE, in hand early, raced between foes, moved five or six wide when rallying into the lane, loomed a solid threat but lacked a late response. KISSASTAR contested the pace at once while outside of UPSWING, took over, made the pace for six furlongs and weakened gradually. UPSWING contested the pace inside of KISSASTAR and was finished entering the stretch. LOUP'S LADY LOVE, forwardly placed early while between foes, faded after seven furlongs .
